- Registration for admission for the new session begins in the month of January.

- 3. Admission is granted strictly on merit basis found during the admission test and personal interview.
- 4. No admission test for nursery standard. However interaction with the child and interview with the parents/guardians is must.

- 3. If a child requires a Transfer Certificate at the end of the academic session, an application must be submitted before 30th March in order to avoid fee dispute.

Promotion -

- Appropriate weightage is given to the Weekly Test, Terminal Test in the Final Exam (2nd Semester). The students as such must obtain maximum marks in all test/exams.
- A student who fails to secure an aggregate of 35% in each subject for promotion to the next class. However one can also be promoted through supplementary exam in extreme cases.
- Students having less than 80% attendance to their credits shall not be allowed to appear annual examinations without valid reason.
- 4. If a student fails to appear any test or examination (test and semester), it will not be possible to re-arrange the lapsed examination on a subsequent date. In case of consequence of serious emergency, with proper justification appropriate weightage in marks will be allowed in the 2nd Semester (Annual) based on weekly test or Terminal tests.



Important for Parents -

- 1. Parents must go through the prospectus. They must understand the rules and conditions of the school before giving admission to their children.
- 2. Parents must co-operate with the school staff in order to maintain congenial atmosphere for studies.
- 3. Students are not permitted to bring money and costly item like wristwatch, ornaments and cell phones in the class.
- No half day leave is granted to any student. However, it may be considered in case of emergency with certain valid reason.
